Hardworking Queenslanders have been recognised for their contribution towards protecting some of the state's most vulnerable children and young people, at the launch of Child Protection Week.

Child Safety Minister Tracy Davis congratulated four individuals as well as eight groups who were recognised for their dedication and commitment at a special ceremony at Parliament House.

"Child Protection Week is the perfect opportunity to acknowledge the selflessness and hard work of everyday Queenslanders who help to prevent child abuse and neglect in our communities," Ms Davis

"Working with children who have experienced abuse or neglect can often be challenging and confronting.

"The role individuals and organisations play in protecting Queensland's children and young people should never be understated."

Ms Davis said an additional award was presented to Joanne Stout from the Townsville Aboriginal and Islander Health Service, for her exceptional work to reconnect children to their family, community and

The awards ceremony marked the Oueensland launch of National Child Protection Week, which runs from 1-7 September 2013.

"The week provides an opportunity to raise awareness of child protection issues and teach young people about how they can best protect themselves," she said.

"I encourage every Queenslander to take part in events across the state to help remind us that we all play a part in making our state the safest place to raise a child."






