BIO

Detective Sergeant Tania Plant has been working to address Child Protection issues for approximately 23 years within the Qld Police Service.

Tania is described by her colleagues as one of the best investigators of Child Protection matters; as someone who possesses superior knowledge about Child Protection and Child Abuse issues. And the work involved in responding to the issues. Her approach is recognised and Tanya is called upon to address difficult and sensitive issues. Tanya is described by her colleagues as reliable, trustworthy, very capable and very thorough – she goes the extra mile – and will locate the evidence or the witness to gain the evidence.

Her team see her as a mentor, building a future group of investigators and modelling the building of relationships with the children she works to protect, other agencies and internally. She is creative in engaging with the children who have been abused sexually, physically and verbally, with exceptional communication skills that gain their trust.
